

Visiting Goldfish Farm in China

As usual I will be traveling to China in the First week of October for my goldfish. As usual I would like to invite you to come with me to select your own goldfish and to see how goldfish are raised in China. We will first fly to Hong Kong (the spring board to China) and from there we will travel by train into China to Jackie Chan's Goldfish Farm. And if you have an extra 10 days to spare please come with me to visit the capital of China, Beijing (see the Great Wall of China, the Forbidden City; Tien An Men Square, the Temple of Heaven etc.); Shanghai, the largest metropolitan city in China; Xi'an (The Tomb of Terra Cotta); Guilin, the pictorial Chinese scenic landscapes.

Date: 10th October 2005 (tentatively).

Duration: Option 1: (Approximately, US\$1650.00 per person [double occupancy].)
4 days (3 nights) in Hong Kong and
2 days (1 night) in Guangdong,
China where the fish farm is
located.

Option 2: (Approximately, US\$2650.00 per person [double occupancy].)
As in Option 1 plus 11 days i.e. a
total of fifteen days and fourteen
night
